WEEK 1

June 26-30 Katie, Adele, Jada S. and Annie

ROCK CLIMBING:

For 2-6th Graders: Katie will focus on different activities that will build strength and endurance, but will also teach life skills such as mental focus, problem solving, achieving goals, and pushing kids out of their comfort zone. Katie will do various top rope and bouldering activities on the climbing wall while teaching kids proper technique with an emphasis on how to climb safely. We will discuss what climbers sometimes refer to as "terms only climbers say". Heel hooks? Barn doors? Beta? Don't know what any of these terms mean? Katie's got you covered. Ultimately, climbing is an amazing sport that kids could be involved with for a lifetime!

For K-1 Graders: Katie will do a variation of climbing that will introduce the younger ones to the sport. While we will not use the actual climbing wall in the Community Building (that is for the 2nd-6th graders) we will use the blue play structure to get the kids started on all things climbing! We will work on certain techniques of the sport like finger strength, footwork, and body positioning while creating fun and interactive relay games that will introduce the kids to what climbing is all about!

BIRD WATCHING: Have you spotted a Starling in Criscuolo Park? Ever wondered about the world of crows on your way to school? This week, let's get to know the birds of Cold Spring! Bring your powers of observation, your creativity, and your willingness to be silly as we learn about the birds around our school. You will create your own field guides for the area, play games that simulate migration, model different beak adaptations, and more!

WEEK 2

July 3-7 Jazlyn, Athena, Jada S.

PUPPET THEATER WORKSHOP: Together we'll explore the world of puppet theater. Learn the process for creating our own puppet theater. We'll use our imagination and creativity to make our own puppets and produce our own puppet theater performances.

COOKING: During this week, we will learn recipes from around the world and cook dishes important to different cultures.

MAKE A MOVIE! Come and produce a movie this week. Children will brainstorm ideas, write a script, act out various parts, add special effects, edit raw footage, add background music and sound effects, apply transitions and titles, and add any final details.
